WHO ARE WE?

We are Community Connections Transport (CCT), a scheme led by Age UK Lewisham and Southwark, dedicated to supporting vulnerable residents of Lewisham, who face physical or psychological challenges that prevent them from using public transport. With your help, we can offer them the freedom to get around.

MAIN ACTIVITIES/TASKS

- To liaise with the transport coordinator regarding requests and arrangements.
- To assist clients, where required, from one destination to another- e.g. lifting mobility equipment, carrying shopping load or opening doors if mobility is limited.
- To collect monies from passengers where applicable and agreed with the Transport coordinator.
- Being prompt and punctual for all pick-ups and drop-offs
- To complete accurate expense claims and drive completion on Optimise
- Informing transport coordinator at the end of appointment.
- Ensure your vehicle is roadworthy i.e. valid insurance, MOT and road tax.
